Georgia Northwestern to Hold 18th Annual J.D. Powell Memorial Golf Tournament

The Georgia Northwestern Technical College (GNTC) Foundation is sponsoring the 18th annual J.D. Powell Memorial Golf Tournament at Barnsley Resort in Adairsville on Tuesday, Oct. 25. Proceeds from the tournament will provide funding and scholarship assistance to GNTC students.

James Derward Powell served as the president of GNTC from 1987-1994.

Registration is now open and is \$600 per team with up to four people on a team. The team fee includes boxed lunch, goody bag, 18 holes of golf with cart, and entry for door prizes. Hole sponsorships are available for \$200 or \$150 when purchased with a team entry. Tent Sponsorships are also available for \$500. Registration is limited and is on a first-come first-serve basis.
