

The Manufacturers' Education Foundation Scholarship

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

The Manufacturers' Education Foundation is providing a scholarship to promote careers in manufacturing. The purpose of the Manufacturers' Education Foundation Scholarship is to reward academic excellence and provide a financial incentive for students working toward the completion of a diploma or degree of a manufacturing-related program at Georgia Northwestern Technical College.

PROGRAM AWARD:

One scholarship will be awarded for the academic year with the possibility of \$500 stipend for three consecutive semesters pending academic progress. A recipient will have the opportunity to receive a maximum of \$1,500 for the academic year.

TARGET AUDIENCE:

- Students who are enrolled as full time students (12 credit hours or more) in one of the following programs:
 - Electrical Construction and Maintenance
 - Electronics and Telecommunications
 - Industrial Systems Technology
 - Machine Tool Technology
 - Welding and Joining Technology
 - Instrumentation and Control
 - Chemical Technician
- Have maintained a GPA of 2.5 (based on a four-point system)
- Have maintained a minimum of a Work Ethics Grade of 2

RESTRICTIONS FOR USE:

- The scholarship's use is restricted to tuition, fees, books, program-specific tools and supplies, and certification testing.
- An account will be established with Georgia Northwestern Technical College Foundation, Inc. for a scholarship recipient for payment of approved expenses.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- Students may apply by completing the Manufacturers' Education Foundation Scholarship application form, which includes:
 1. An essay (500 words or less) about why they should receive the scholarship and how it will aid them in completing their technical education. Applicants may include information about why they have chosen their field of study as their career goal. Other information may include employment/internship experience in manufacturing.
 2. One letter of recommendation from an advisor, staff member, supervisor, or associate on student's behalf.
