



## Rome Home Builders Association Scholarship

### Scholarship Program Overview:

The purpose of the Rome Home Builders Association Scholarship is to reward academic excellence and provide a financial incentive for students working toward the completion of a diploma, degree or certification in Construction-related programs on the Floyd, Gordon (Calhoun) and Polk County (Cedartown) Campuses.

### Program Awards:

Scholarship awards will be made to two (2) students for \$500 each.

### Target Audience

- Construction Management Programs
- Drafting Technology
- Horticulture
- Lawn Maintenance Specialist
- Air Conditioning Technology Programs
- Residential Energy Efficiency Technology
- CAD Operator Mechanical
- Green Building Technician
- Residential Wiring Technician

### Students who:

- Are enrolled as full time students (12 credit hours or more) in Construction-related programs
- Have maintained a GPA of 3.0 (based on a four-point system)

### Restrictions for Use

- The scholarship's use is restricted to program-specific tuition, tools, supplies, fees, books and certification testing.
- An account will be established with Georgia Northwestern Technical College Foundation, Inc. for a scholarship recipient for payment of approved expenses.

### Application Process

- Students may apply by completing the Rome Home Builders Scholarship application form.
- In addition to the application form, the applicants must submit:
  - Unofficial Transcript
  - An essay (300 words or less) about why they should receive the scholarship and how it will aid them in completing their technical education. Applicants may include information about why they have chosen their field of study as their career goal. Other information may be included such as community involvement or background about their personal circumstances that are relevant to the selection process.
  - One letter of recommendation from an advisor, staff member or associate on their behalf.
