



The HOPE Career Grant provides an opportunity for students to complete a program of study leading to a high demand career. The HOPE Career Grant pays **100% of the cost of tuition** for one and two year technical programs of study with the 22 institutions of the Technical College System of Georgia. Students pay the remaining cost of college fees, books, and materials each semester.

Students must meet the qualifications required for the basic HOPE Grant to be eligible to receive the enhanced benefits of the HOPE Career Grant. Many area employers are seeking qualified employees who complete one of the technical programs of study. The following programs of study are eligible for the HOPE Career Grant:
