Enhance student access and success

Objectives

- Increase the application-to-registration conversion rate each academic year with a focus on strategic areas.
- Increase the percentage of students retained each academic year with a focus on strategic areas.
- Increase the number of graduates each year with a focus on strategic areas.
- Class schedules will be designed for student success and student flexibility.
- Increase dual enrollment and high school equivalency (HSE) conversion rate each year.
- Provide programs and services that promote equity.

Goal 2 Academic Quality

Provide a quality learning environment and academic support services for students.

Objectives

- Exceed required passage rates set by program accreditors or state agencies in programs that require licensure or certification for employment.
- Programs without a licensure or certification needed for employment, will utilize an industryrecognized standardized instrument and will exceed the instrument's national benchmark.
- Meet high school equivalency (HSE) passage rates set by the Technical College System of Georgia.
- Increase student usage of tutoring services and library services.

- Ensure credit programs offered meet the current needs of business and industry in the service area.
- Recruit and retain qualified faculty.
- Provide targeted instructional support and training to programs who need assistance meeting benchmarks.
- Evaluate the design and development of online courses annually.

- Manage financial resources in a fiscally sound and sustainable manner.
- Enhance activities to build public and private financial support for the advancement of the college.
