- Classes for this program are offered at the Floyd County Campus and Walker County Campus (schedules may vary).
- This program cannot be completed in the evening only. Day and evening courses are required throughout the program.
- The following supplies will be required for the program. Contact Program Advisor for detailed list of supplies and purchasing recommendations.
 - Textbooks
 - An automotive uniform: navy pant w/ navy button up shirt OR navy pants w/navy GNTC t-shirt. Hat is optional.
 - Tools which meet industry standards quality; drive sets (multiple sizes required), wrenches, screwdriver sets, pliers, miscellaneous items. Tools are needed by the second month of class.
