

Practical Nursing Diploma Admission Notes:

Admission Requirements

All applicants to the PN program must meet the following requirements:

- 1) Be 18 or more years of age.
- 2) Meet all GNTC admission requirements.
- 3) Contact Brandi Thompson, bthompson@gntc.edu, to be assigned a PN program advisor.
- 4) Submit a PN Eligibility Request Form: https://www.gntc.edu/pn-eligibility/.
- 5) Successfully pass the HESI Pre-Admission Exam.
- 6) Students will be ranked based on the selection criteria above and the cohort selected.

Class Acceptance

The Practical Nursing program is a competitive admission program. PN classes are accepted twice a year, each spring and each fall. Class acceptance is based on a point* system consisting of the HESI pre-admission exam score. Students will be ranked based on the selection criteria above and the cohort selected.

Once accepted into the program it will take a student one year to complete.

*An additional 2 points will be added to the admission score for students who hold a currently valid CNA license.

Deadlines Dates:

If you wish to be considered for the Spring PN class that begins in January you must have the HESI pre-admission exam by **November 15**th of each year.


If you wish to be considered for the Fall PN class that begins in August you must have completed the HESI pre-admission exam by **June 15**th of each year.
