



Program Outcomes

Graduates of the ASN program will be eligible to sit for the NCLEX-RN licensure exam. Once the graduate passes this national exam, they may be licensed by the state's board of nursing to which the application has been made. When the graduate has been licensed, they may practice as a Registered Nurse (RN) in the state in which the license is granted, as well as other states that are included in a multistate licensure compact.

Program Completion and Job Placement Results

On-time completion rate is considered four semesters without interruption.

- 2024 – On-time program completion rate: 33.33%, Job Placement Rate: 100%
- 2023 – On-time program completion rate: 26.47%, Job Placement Rate: 100%
- 2022 – On-time program completion rate: 61.76%, Job Placement Rate: 100%
- 2021 – On-time program completion rate: 61.54%, Job Placement Rate: 97%
- 2020 – On-time program completion rate: 88.46%, Job Placement Rate: 97%
