Paramedicine Diploma Planning Notes:

- Classes for this Diploma are offered at the Gordon County Campus.
- The Paramedicine Diploma is a diploma for students who are already an AEMT and wish to continue to Paramedic. Student must have successfully passed an AEMT program and hold an EMT certificate or license. This includes pre-occupational courses that must be completed before being accepted into the program.
- Students must submit an Eligibility Form request and be accepted into the program.
- Students must also attend a program specific orientation before the start of the EMSP courses. If accepted into the program, information regarding program specific orientation will be sent out with the acceptance letter.
- The Paramedicine Diploma program is a 3-semester program. Occupational Curriculum must be taken as ordered in each set of suggested courses to complete the program. Partial enrollment of courses is not permitted.
